DIRECTIONS TO REACH THE LIDO DI VENEZIA FROM MARCO POLO AIRPORT

Below you will find detailed instructions on how to reach the Lido di Venezia from Venice Marco Polo Airport using water transportation (public or private).

How to reach the water transport dock

1. Upon exiting the “Arrivals” area of the airport, take the escalators up to the 1st floor.




2. Proceed toward the security checkpoints and pass through them.
3. After the security area, you will see a large sign in front of you reading “Water Transport”.

4. Follow the signs to the dock:

- walk along the moving walkway;
- continue via the escalator or take the elevator down to the lower level.



5. Once at the dock level, follow the signs for “**Alilaguna**” (public water transport).



You will arrive directly at the dock where both public and private boats depart for Venice and the Lido.

Public water transport (Alilaguna)

At the dock you will find the boats of the public Alilaguna service.
We recommend checking the updated schedules (attached) and selecting the most convenient line to reach the Lido di Venezia.


Private water taxi
